
### 1972 Packers overcame all obstacles, except their own coach and Washington

he Green Bay Packers have had so many successful teams — including an NFL-leading 13 championships — it's hard to get recognition if you're only moderately successful, even if that success came during one of the team's streaks of long-term awfulness. • Meet the 1972 division-winning Green Bay Packers, whose 10-4 record interrupted a streak of 10 NFC Central championships by the Minnesota Vikings. • It's the only championship of any sort by the Packers between the Ice Bowl year in 1967 and the next division championship in 1995. # State has record cash surplus

Stage set for fight over how to use \$4.3 billion

MADISON - Wisconsin officials have an unprecedented amount of cash heading into January when lawmakers return to begin writing the next state budget — a game-changing sum that could be used to cut taxes, slash borrowing or transform funding for schools.

Tax collections and lower-than-expected state spending have swelled the state surplus to \$4.3 billion — \$1.5 billion more than projected in January, according to the state Department of Administration.

The state's so-called rainy day fund, which is supposed to be tapped only during recessions and emergencies, also reached a record \$1.7 billion, according to Gov. Tony Evers' administration.
